

# Paddy Eger

## Two Card Pile Up

Partner  
Difficulty Level: Varies  
Math Operations: A, S  
Time: varies

**OBJECTIVES:** To play all your cards before your partner

**MATERIALS:**

- 2 decks of cards with contrasting back designs
- 2 sets of number tabs ranging from 1 - 10 with a **Greater Than** tab

**BEST USE:** Addition and subtraction practice

**RULES:**

1. Place the number tags in order, lowest number to highest. (You will place your pairs of cards below the number of your solution to your problem.)
2. Remove all face cards, Use Aces as '1'.
3. Shuffle the decks together. Deal out all the cards from one deck **face down** for **each** player.
4. On a start signal, turn up 2 cards as quickly as possible. Add or subtract the numbers. Place the 2 cards below the number tag that matches your answer.

Example:

Player 'A' turns up 2 and 4.  $2+4=6$  Place the cards **face down** below '6'.  
OR  $4-2=2$  Place the cards **face down** below '2'.

Player 'B' turns up 10 and 4.  $10-4=6$  Place the cards **face down** below '6'.  
OR Add  $10+4=14$ . Use the **Greater Than column** and place the cards **face down** below the Greater Than tab.

5. The winner is the first person to place at least **two pair** of cards below each number tab by laying out/using all of their cards in combinations.

**OPTIONS:**

- Write out each equation to lengthen the game. (add paper and a pencil)
- Only add.
- Only subtract
- Make number tabs to include higher numbers.
- Make number tabs that include negative numbers.
